



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This MoU is made on 30 Nov 2023 between:

Indian Institute of Technology Gandhinagar, located at Palaj, Gandhinagar 382055, Gujarat (hereinafter called IITGN, which expression shall include its successors and assignees) on the second part,

AND

GLA University, located at Mathura, Uttar Pradesh 281406 (hereinafter called GLA, which expression shall include its successors and assignees) on the first part

IITGN and GLA shall individually be known as a Party and Collectively as Parties

Scope:

The scope of collaboration in this Memorandum of Understanding includes initiatives under the following categories:

- I. Exchange of students for summer research internship programme (SRIP) at IITGN;
- II. Opportunity to GLA students to study for a semester at IITGN

Now therefore, the Parties, record their understanding and define the steps to be taken to implement this MOU

1. Exchange of students for Summer Research Internship Programme (SRIP) at IITGN:

- a) IITGN encourages students of GLA to apply for SRIP offered by IITGN during the summer vacations.
- b) The programme may be conducted in online/ offline mode at the discretion of IITGN.
- c) IITGN shall provide a stipend during the internship period to the selected students who successfully complete the full duration of programme. However, IITGN shall not provide travel to and from IITGN for attending the programme.
- d) Selected students have to comply with all the rules and regulations prescribed by IITGN during their stay at IITGN.

2. Opportunity to GLA students to study a semester at IITGN:

- a) Students enrolled in BTech programmes at GLA can spend a semester at IITGN under Visiting Students Programme.
- b) The credits earned during the semester shall be transferred to GLA.
- c) The student has to complete all the academic requirements as prescribed by IITGN during the semester.
- d) The student is required to pay to IITGN the tuition fee and other charges for hostel, mess etc. during the semester as per the rates applicable to IITGN students.
- e) Selected students have to comply with all the rules and regulations prescribed by IITGN during their stay at IITGN.

3. Terms, termination and amendments:

- a) This MoU will remain valid for three years from the effective date.

- b) This MoU may be amended, renewed, or terminated by mutual agreement. The termination shall be by a prior notice of not less than three months by either of the parties.
- c) In case of termination, mutual concern/agreement has to be arrived for the protecting and respecting the obligations of either of the parties under ongoing studies of students.

4. Force Majeure:

Neither party shall be held responsible for non-fulfilment of their respective obligation under the agreement due to the exigency of one or more of the force majeure events such as but not limited to Acts of God, War, Flood, Earthquakes, Strike(s) Lockouts (s), Epidemics, Riots, Civil commotion etc provided on occurrence and cessation of such events, the part affected by these shall give a notice in writing to the other within one month of such occurrence and cessation. If the major conditions continue beyond six months, the parties shall then mutually decide about the future course of action.







5. Governing Law:

The validity and interpretation of this MoU and the legal relation of the Parties to it shall be governed by the laws of India.

6. Dispute Resolution:

Any dispute or difference arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall be settled by the Parties hereto by mutual negotiation involving the leadership of both the Institutes.
